Page 3 - Article 7.b. Members shall be notified by mail at least 10 days in advance of any meetings.

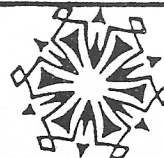

Page 3 - Article 7.b. Members shall be notified by mail at least 10 days in advance of any meetings.

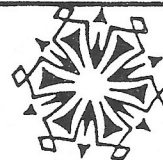
