TREE PLANTING CEREMONY:

Sunday, March 5, 1989, the Lacey Historical Society will sponsor their third annual TREE PLANTING CEREMONY at the Lacey Community Museum on Lacey Street. This tree planting ceremony provides an opportunity for the Lacey Historical Society and community leaders to honor persons of the Lacey area who have contributed to the success of our community and, particularly, to the heritage of our community.

Persons who have been honored in previous ceremonies have included Frank Bower, Pete Finnegan, Anna Homann, Myrtle and Cecil O Neil, William Robbins, Elizabeth Fleetwood, Dick Webb, and John Mangham among others.

The trees or shrubs are donated by family or friends of the person being honored. The usual cost for this can vary between \$10 - \$45 depending upon the size and variety of the plant being donated. All plants are purchased through College Street Nursery. The plants are set into the ground the day before the ceremony by volunteers of the Lacey Historical Society. Al plants are planted in the areas designated by the Lacey Parks Department (on the Lacey Museum property) and by the Lacey Historical Society (on the adjacent Historical Society property around the Gallagher House).

At the time you call, please be prepared to give us the name of the person you wish to be honored; the amount you wish to pay (a price range is preferable); and information on who is paying for the plant. Money fo the plants is due on the day of the planting ceremony - or earlier if possible.
